Your organization has just opened a new regional office. Ernie, your IT administrator, needs to make accessible your organization's local files at the new office.



The new office is full of new-hires who will need to stream the videos on the organization's training site.

Step 1



Ernie will use DocAve File Share Navigator, which allows for exposing files, including large, media rich files in SharePoint through direct hyperlinks.

Step 2



Using File Share Navigator, Ernie creates a new File Share Links list in SharePoint.

Step 3





He maps the new list to the file system directory in which the video content resides, by using the folder path.

Step 4



Ernie then runs a sync, and the content from the file share becomes accessible in SharePoint.

Step 5



All of your organizations employees can now access the files they need via links in SharePoint, streaming video without burdening the Web front-endserver.
