

Support for Private Channels

Looking for the ability to create a channel that only channel members can see. Private channels are available in slack. There is an admin for private channels who is the creator, and they are the ones who add/remove users.

Five types of public/privacy that is being asked for by users:

- Public-Open (visible anywhere including outside the org and anyone can join)
- Public-Invitation (visible anywhere including outside the org, must be invited)
- Company-Open (only visible inside the org and anyone in the org can join; outside the org must be invited)
- Company-Invitation (only visible inside the org, must be invited)
- Secret (invisible to everyone except existing members, must be invited)

Permission structure

Big picture



Permission structure

- User must first be in a Team to be in a PC
- External guests are supported
- Team owners don't necessarily have PC access



Private channels – a "subteam" of a team


Who can create a private channel?

Every member/owner can create a private channel (if no restrictions applied)

Who has access to a private channel?

1. Invited members have access
2. Team owner has no access if not invited

PC owners



Permission structure

- Members can create PCs (except external guests)
- Creator becomes the PC owner
- Add members and owners
- Can manage PC membership & files



Team owners



Permission structure

- Can limit who can create PCs
- Can only see name & description of PC
- Can be added to PC, but not necessary
- Limited responsibility & accessibility



Team and/or PC members



Permission structure

- PC members can converse and update files
- If not a PC member, PC is invisible



Membership rights synopsis

Feature	Team member	Team owner
Name and description	Only when invited	Every channel in the team
Conversation and tabs		Only when invited
Files and contents		Only when invited
Private channel owner		Every channel in the team



Files

Team and/or PC members



Files

- PC creates a separate SharePoint site collection
- Site permissions coupled to Private Channel
- Manage permissions from Teams
- Not a standard Team Site (e.g., no Pages)

Why this way?



Files

- PCs owned by high-level folks storing sensitive material may not want Team owner to access
- Only way to ensure no permissions loophole through parent Team site



Administration

Microsoft Teams



Administration

- PCs are enabled by default – check *now*
- Can disable PCs at the tenant level
- Team owners can disable at Team level
 - Go check your Org-wide Teams!
- PCs can go ownerless!



SharePoint



Administration

- PC sites do *not* surface in the SharePoint Admin Center (by design)
- SharePoint security groups can be used, but don't mess with owner and member groups



Information protection



Administration

- AIP/MIP classification is same as in the parent Team
- DLP in PC conversations is inherited from the Team
- DLP in PC files is separate from DLP in the parent Team
- Retention polices are not working yet for conversations

Provisioning



Self-service, managed, or a combination?

Ongoing Management



Tracking data ownership

Gather, maintain and report on common governance details (division, purpose, sensitivity, etc.).

Recertification

Require periodic review of permissions, membership, ownership etc.?

Expiration, End of Life



“Managed” de-provisioning processes?

For “workspaces” like sites and Teams?

For content within workspaces?
