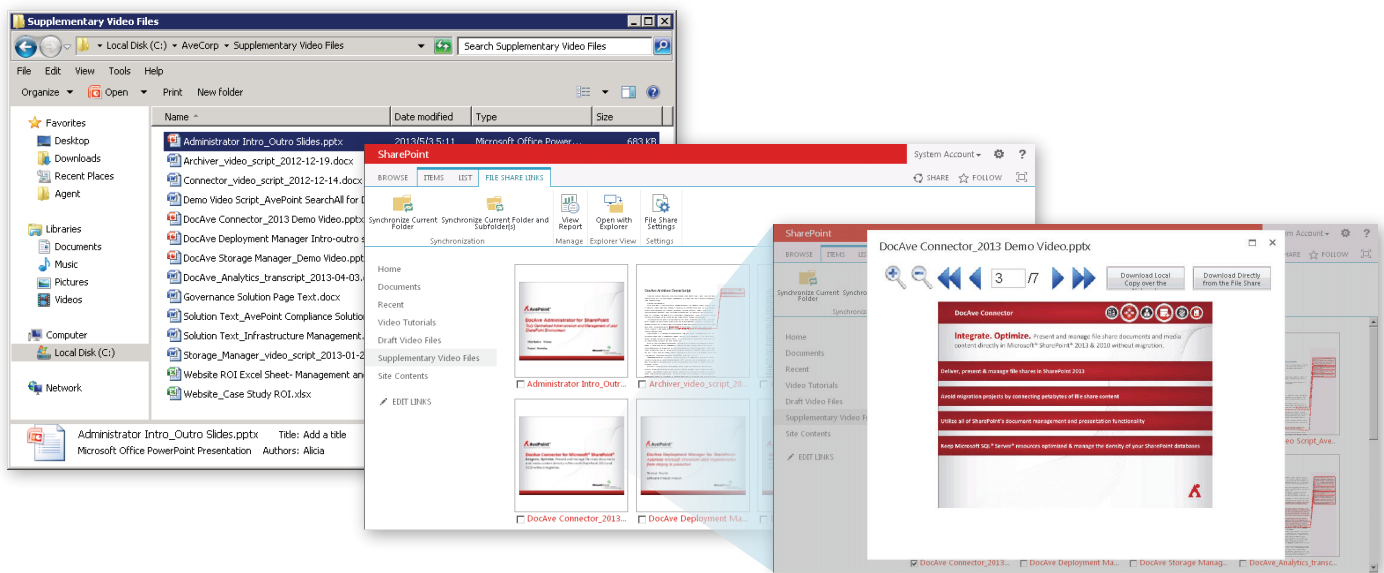

DocAve File Share Navigator removes the barriers to seamless global collaboration by exposing large files, rich media, and a variety of other file share content in SharePoint Server 2016, 2013, and 2010 without migration. Enhance enterprise-wide content management and breathe new life into shared drives – regardless of whether they reside locally or in public cloud offerings like Microsoft Azure or Dropbox – by allowing users to preview and download file-based content directly through SharePoint. All legacy files are displayed as links on SharePoint lists, helping administrators consolidate file server access into SharePoint and providing for local or remote end-user access without degrading SharePoint performance.

Technical Overview

- Allow end users to browse for and access all enterprise content through SharePoint – including files larger than 10 GB, Microsoft Access data, .exe and .irm files, and Excel Share books – leveraging Server Message Block (SMB) and SharePoint's HTTP protocols
- Without installing additional programs, preview large files such as PowerPoint, Word, Excel, Adobe PDF files, and CAD file types from multiple end points, including mobile devices
- Connect any UNC-accessible file share folder or files stored in public cloud offerings – such as Microsoft Azure or Dropbox – with SharePoint and expose file share content as links in a SharePoint list, allowing users to access and interact with file-based content through SharePoint without migration
- Supports SharePoint metadata-based search, and content creation from both file servers and SharePoint, allowing for seamless collaboration
- Supports synchronization of permissions from the file server to SharePoint to streamline permissions management across content repositories
- Upload properties such as "last modified time" directly updated on file server to SharePoint automatically, and leverage existing file properties as SharePoint metadata
- Lightweight installation requires no additional infrastructure; no Microsoft External BLOB Storage (EBS) or Remote BLOB Storage (RBS) API configuration; and deploys as a solution into your SharePoint environment
