

### Event

## Step 1

Using Connector, Ernie creates a new Connector library.

Ernie maps to the file system directories that all of his content resides in using the folder path.

## Step 4



Ernie runs a sync, and the file share content becomes accessible in SharePoint.

All of your organization's employees can now access and edit the files they need, taking advantage of full SharePoint functionality including full-text search, Office Web Apps and version tracking.
